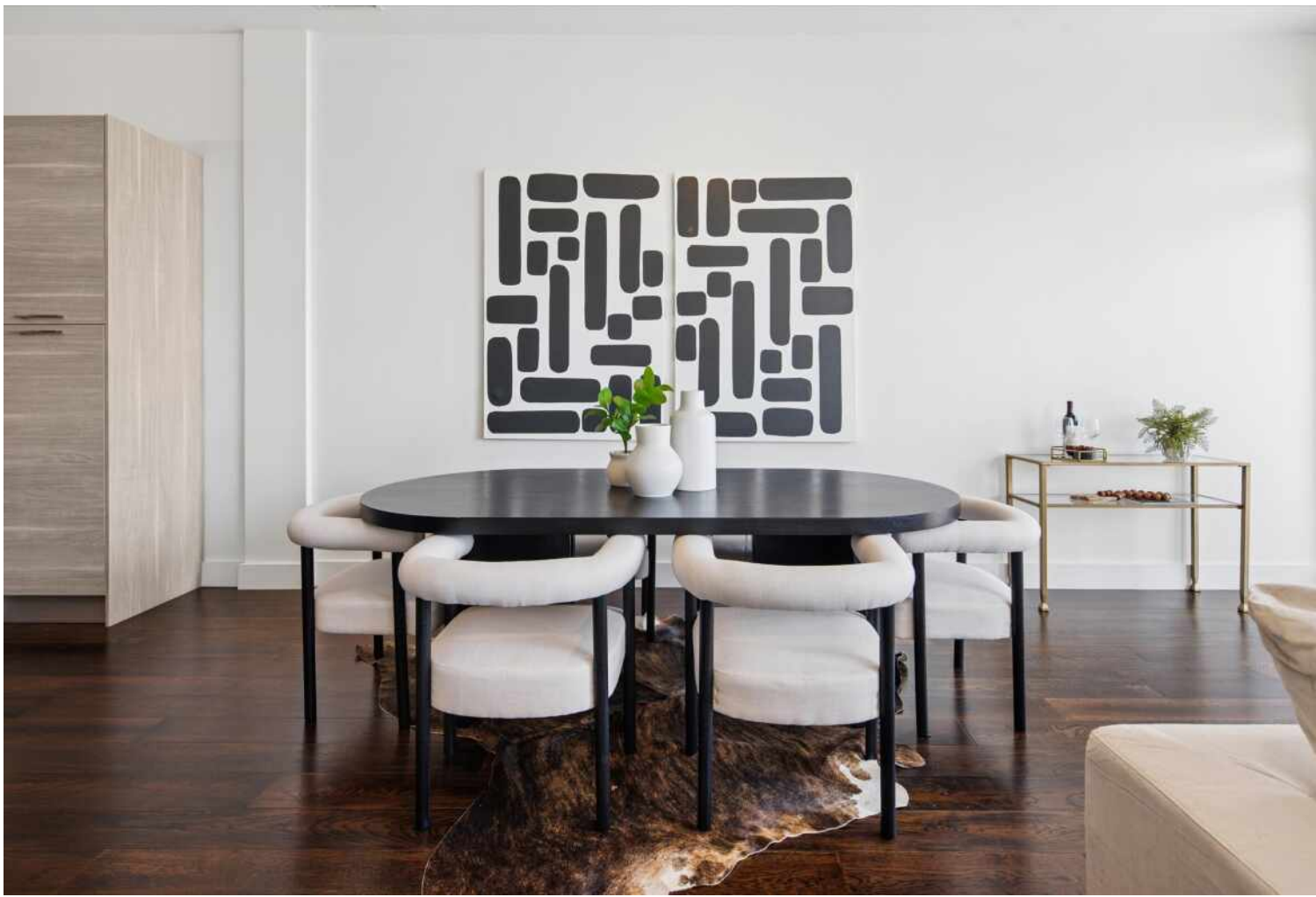


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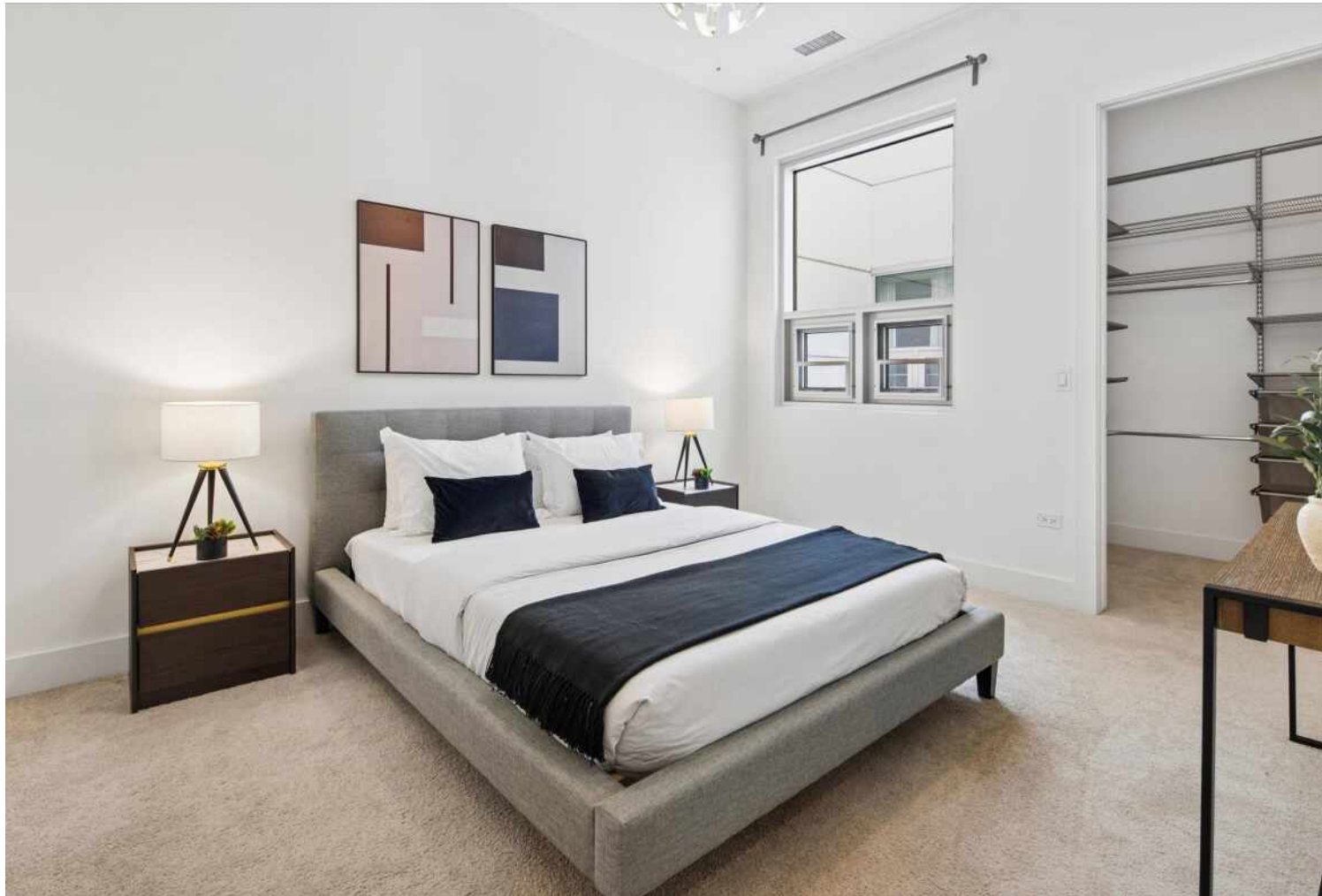












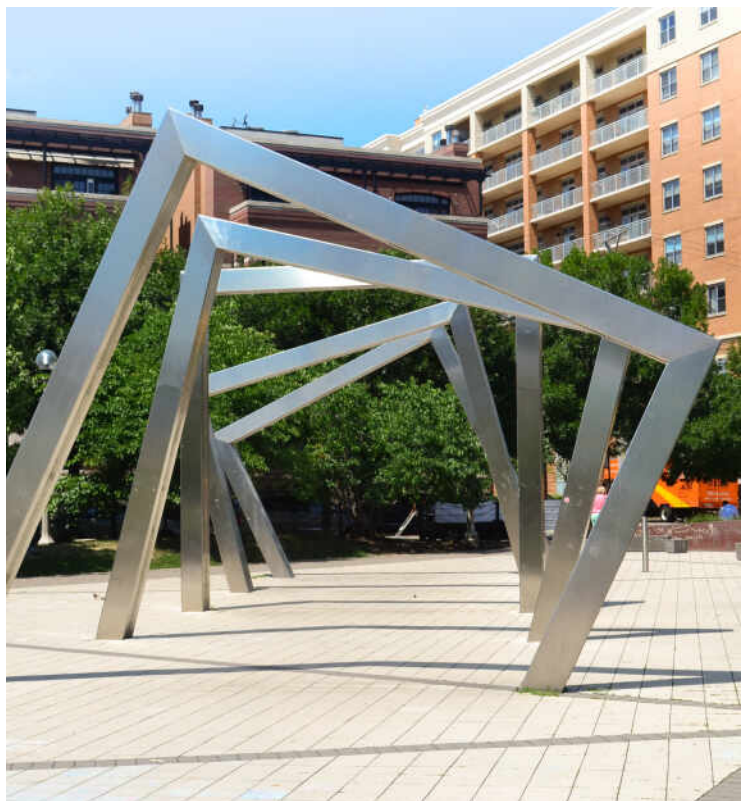












FEW NEIGHBORHOODS HAVE UNDERGONE A TRANSFORMATION QUITE LIKE THE **WEST LOOP.**

Locals love this foodie haven. In addition to nationally-acclaimed restaurants, residents enjoy the West Loop's urban character and seemingly endless schedule of community events.

What was once a meatpacking district has quickly become one of the hottest neighborhoods in Chicago – and it's shown no sign of slowing down.

The West Loop is home to a thriving restaurant district on Randolph Street, where you'll find Michelin-starred favorites and celebrity chefs. But the dining scene doesn't end there. In fact, diners also enjoy an assortment of nearby restaurants in Greektown and Fulton Market.
