



HIGHLAND IS MORE THAN A SMALL TOWN.

It's a community full of unique traditions like world-championship pingpong tournaments and an early Fourth of July celebration. It's also a haven for nature enthusiasts.

The nearby Hoosier Prairie State Nature Preserve boasts 1,547 acres with several trails for visitors to see native plants and animals. Highland's Heron Rookery is a bird watcher's paradise, showcasing blue herons, owls, and a variety of other native and migratory birds.

Highland residents have access to dozens of area parks with a number of amenities. Wicker Memorial Park features an 18-hole golf course, a playground, picnic areas, a splash pad, three miles of trails, volleyball and tennis courts, and a dog run.
