The village masterfully blends diverse business, hospitality, entertainment, and retail with nature, recreation, and residential areas.

Housing in the picturesque village includes single-family homes, townhomes, and condominiums nestled among parks, green spaces, and forest preserves.

Several office parks house prominent employers with a workforce of thousands and square footage in the millions.

Lincolnshire is home to several hotels including Marriott's sprawling Lincolnshire Resort with 170 acres of hotel rooms, restaurants, lounges, a PGA championship golf course, event space, and an acclaimed live musical theater that draws audiences from throughout the region. For those who prefer their entertainment on the big screen, Lincolnshire's massive movie theater has 21 screens to fit the bill.

The village is also a shopping and dining destination with fine dining restaurants, national chains, and several specialty shops. Popular local events include the Taste of Lincolnshire and an annual art festival. A number of public parks can also be found throughout the community.

Lincolnshire is bordered by I-94, with an interchange at Route 22, Milwaukee Avenue, and other major arterial streets as well. Commuter trains stop in nearby communities such as Vernon Hills and Buffalo Grove.
