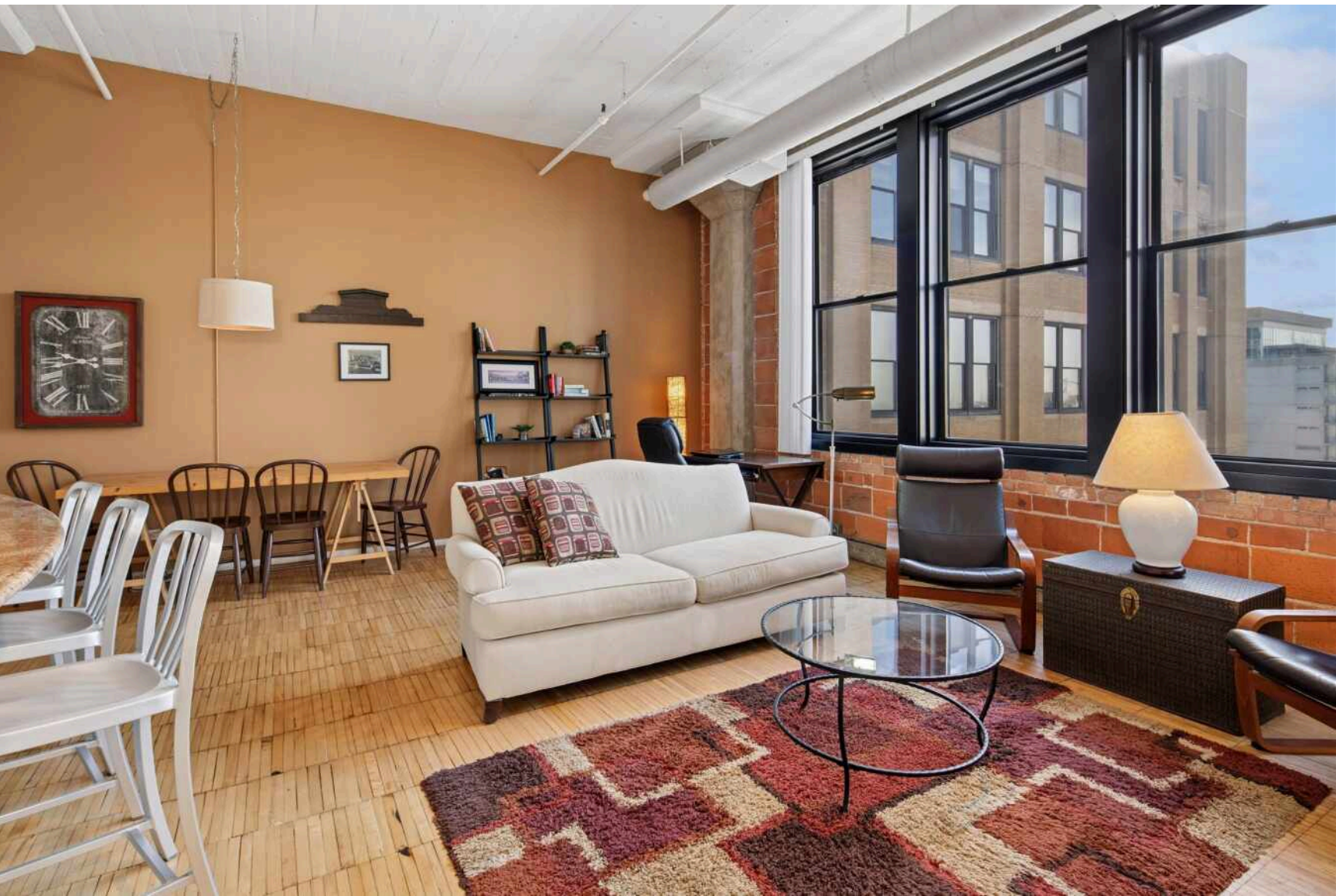

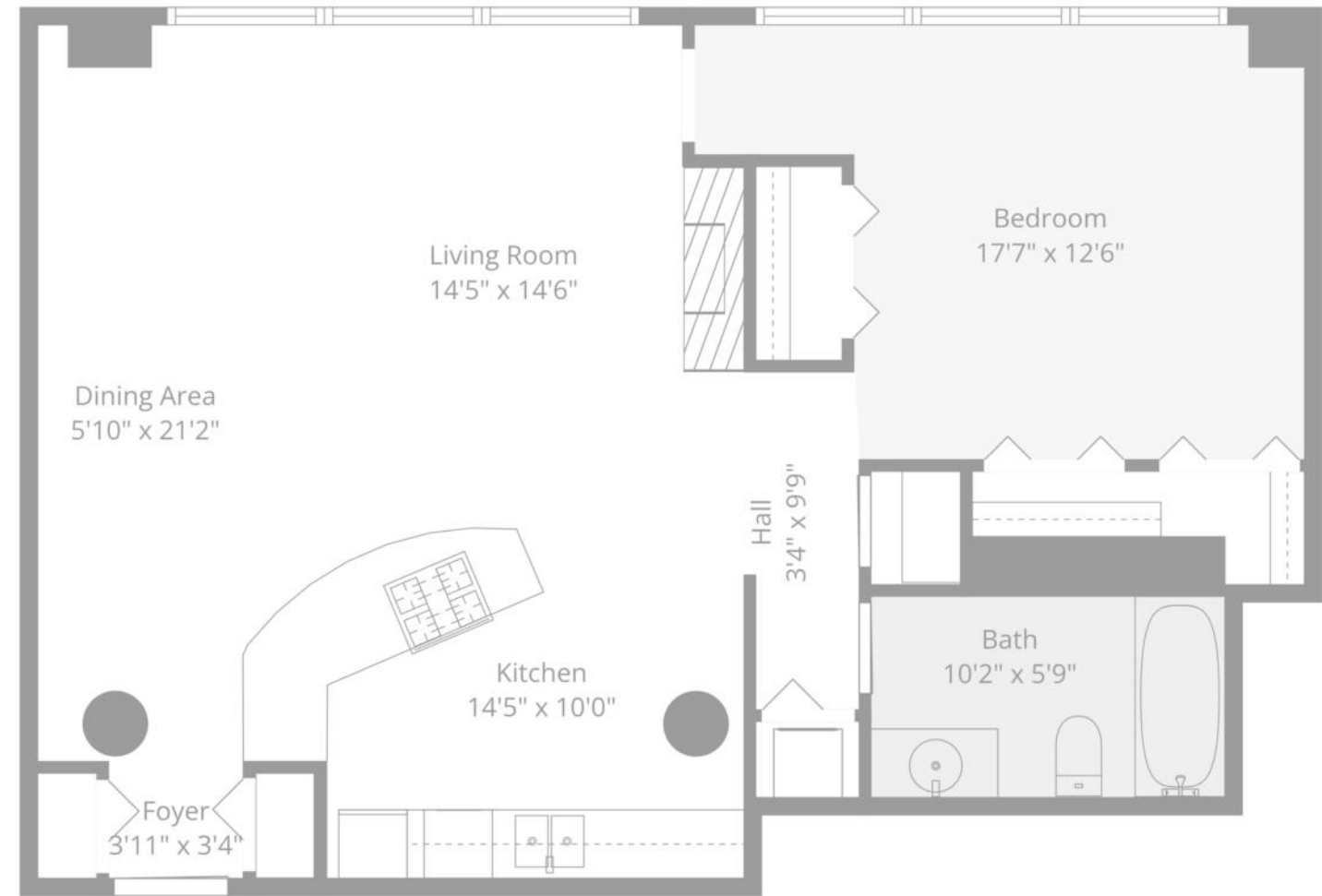

FEW NEIGHBORHOODS HAVE UNDERGONE A TRANSFORMATION QUITE LIKE THE **WEST LOOP**.

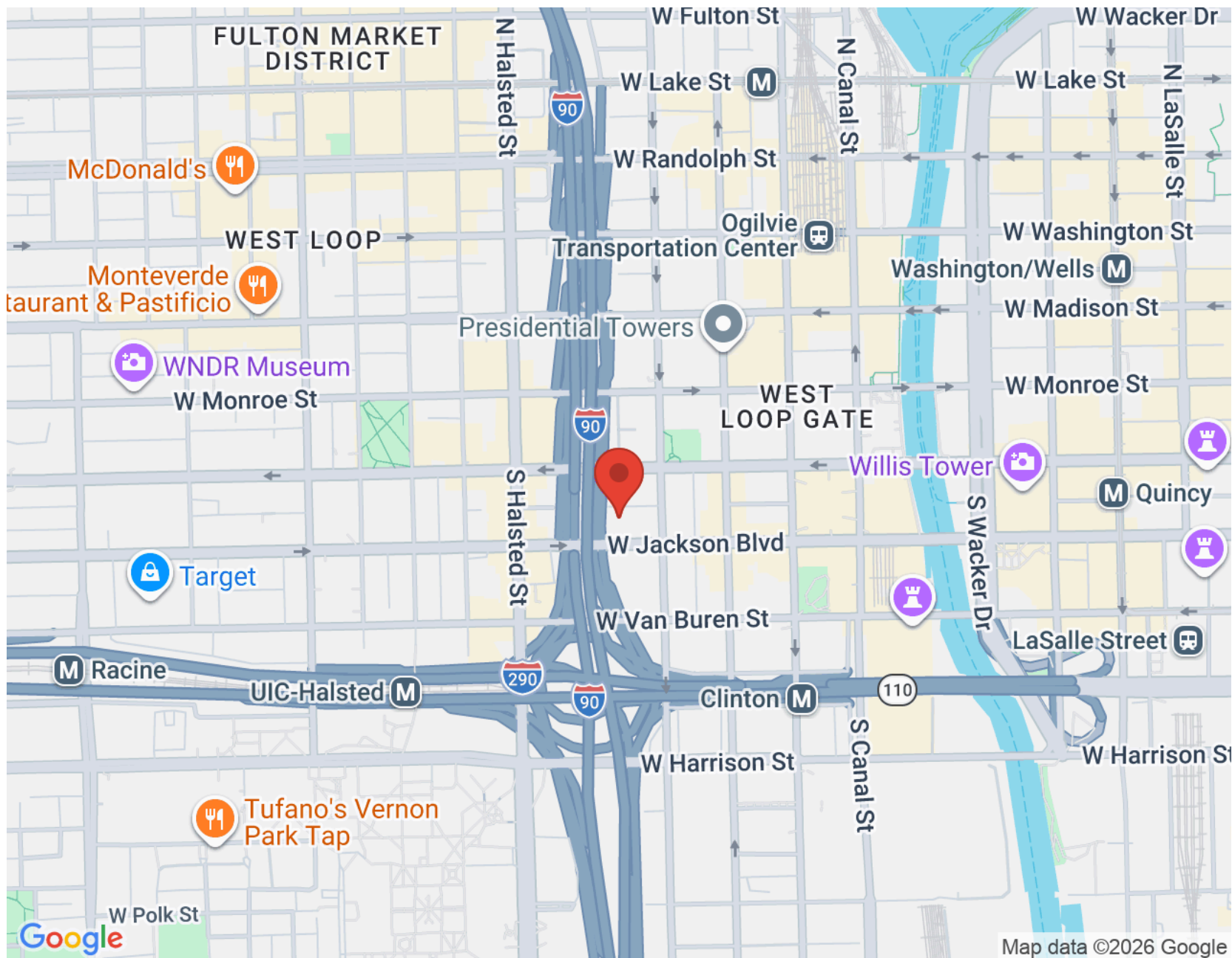
What was once a meatpacking district has quickly become one of the hottest neighborhoods in Chicago – and it’s shown no sign of slowing down.
