Originally designed in 1923 by acclaimed architect Russell Walcott and artfully reimagined in 2008 by Steven Rugo, the residence offers timeless sophistication for both everyday living and grand entertaining. Secluded from the street, the home captivates with limewashed brick facade, lush grounds, and a welcoming front porch. Inside, the gracious foyer introduces exquisite millwork, soaring 10-foot ceilings, and original architectural detailing carried throughout. The formal living room, flows seamlessly into the inviting family room which opens to private outdoor terraces and a sunroom that extends the living space. The dining room, also connects effortlessly to the terraces for indoor-outdoor living. At the heart of the home, the renovated chef's kitchen with coffered ceiling, custom cabinetry, top-of-the-line appliances, butler's pantry, and wet bar opens directly to the bluestone terrace. A versatile office/mudroom completes the main level. A curved staircase with original moldings leads to the second floor foyer. The primary suite is a serene retreat featuring a sitting area, and spa-inspired bath. Three additional bedrooms, with renovated en-suite baths complete the second level. The fully renovated third floor offers a large recreation room, fifth bedroom, and full bath. Landscape architect Craig Bergmann designed enchanting gardens, bluestone terraces, and spa for year-round enjoyment. A rare offering, this is truly a home to be cherished for generations.



Locals love the architecturally significant homes, flawless landscaping, and scenic lakefront setting – all of which contribute to Lake Forest's effortless beauty. The community also has a quaint downtown with a variety of shops and restaurants at Market Square.

Rich in history, the community offers true luxury in a resort-style setting. Historic estates built by legendary architects Howard Van Doren Shaw, David Adler, and Henry Ives Cobb are interspersed among elegant homes with impeccable landscaping.
