



506 SHERIDAN ROAD

This one-of-a-kind majestic home designed by notable architect, Mayo & Mayo, falls into a different era of architecture, executed with flawless Artisan architectural details that could never be replicated today. Incredible, unexpected full sports court on the third floor with 16-foot ceilings places this home in a league of its own on the North Shore. Prominently perched off Sheridan Road with seasonal lake views and meticulously manicured grounds originally designed by landscape architect, Jensen, surround the C-shaped grey Belgian cobble front driveway. The grand entrance is flanked by two oversized urns, intricate ironwork, matching the stone-carved medallions and black double doors with highly placed antique doorknobs. Classic black and white checkered marble flooring sets the formal tone in the entry foyer. The wide cascading staircase, phenomenal soaring ceilings with intricate detailing, arched windows, and refined millwork are some of the special features of this timeless beauty.

The gracious first floor has a wide reception hallway that flows into the dramatic living room with a cascading cocktail patio out to the manicured grounds and ample side yard. The beautiful reception foyer opens to a handsome walnut-paneled library with a custom plaster dome ceiling, elegant dining room with gold leaf ceiling medallions, and family room with access to the kitchen and back staircase. Off the family and dining room is the open Chef's kitchen with attached breakfast room and side entry mudroom leading out to the alfresco patio with Kalamazoo grill and pizza making station.

A sweeping staircase leads you to the second-floor landing with a split floor plan. The master suite wing is located on one end, while an office, laundry room, and four additional family-sized bedrooms sharing two Jack & Jill bedrooms are at the other end. Truly unexpected and equally unbelievable third level with a full industrial level sports court, work out rooms, conference office center, and a full bath. The full lower level has a billiards room with a wet bar, and built-in game booth. Additional guest suite with full bath, kitchenette, and access to the attached 2.5 car garage with an additional two car detached garage also on this level.

The surrounding glorious grounds, stone patios, and terraces provide the perfect backdrop to this prominent home. At the end of the day, where else can you shoot hoops overlooking Lake Michigan and join Zoom calls from a Walnut paneled office or a full working conference room? 506 Sheridan is the ultimate North Shore oasis...there couldn't be a better time for this memorable house to be cherished by the next owners!




INDOOR HIGHLIGHTS


Kenilworth's allure was no accident. In fact, the community was conscientiously designed to provide residents the utmost in beauty and privacy as well as proximity to downtown Chicago. Today it remains one of the most affluent communities in the Midwest.

Founded in 1889 by Joseph Sears, Kenilworth has fewer than 1,000 homes within its .6-mile radius; and notably no large businesses. The village was designed around its town assembly hall, the Kenilworth Club, to make the most of its natural beauty. The community's innovative design captured the attention of architects during the 1893 Columbian Exposition in Chicago.

Kenilworth's lakefront mansions complement comfortable Prairie-style homes by architect and original resident George Maher. Noted architect Franklin Burnham designed the railroad station and several original homes. Spectacular new construction is also available to homebuyers but must meet strict architectural standards to maintain Kenilworth's tradition of elegance.

Schools in the community include top-rated Joseph Sears School and New Trier High School, which consistently ranks among the top high schools in the country according to U.S. News.

Residents enjoy dining out in nearby villages or enjoying a short ride into the city from the Kenilworth Metra Station. A beautiful public beach, flowing fountains, cozy parks, an active historical society, and annual traditions such as a Memorial Day parade preserve the community's charm.
